BIDS

2022 Asphalt and Milling Project

Public Works Siler addressed the Council stating that the purpose of this agenda item is to approve bids for road surface improvements by asphalt overlay. This project is for the resurfacing of approximately 7.8 miles in the TIF area, 3.6 miles of City streets and nearly ¾ of a mile of cemetery roads with new asphalt. Three bids were sent out and three bids were received back.

Emery, Sapp & Sons	\$2,100,280.02
Blevins Asphalt	\$1,856,487.55
APAC Central	\$1,965,533.30

There is \$1,477,865.99 available in the TIF fund. To utilize these funds, we would like to add additional 2,163 tons to the project. This additional tonnage will be utilized on Hwy 59 for wedging purposes. Total project with additional tonnage is \$2,013,339.14.

Mayor DeWitt asked if there was any further business to come before Council, with no response, he asked for a

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
motion to adjourn; a motion was made by Councilman Davidson; seconded by Councilwoman Thomas

Mayor DeWitt adjourned the regular session meeting at 9:09 a.m.


