**INTRODUCTION OF NEW ORDINANCES (1<sup>ST</sup> READING)**

**Bill No. 2022-46: Change Order for Blevins Asphalt Construction**

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City of Neosho, Missouri, to enter into a First Amendment to Agreement for Construction Services with Blevins Asphalt Construction Company, Inc., a Missouri Corporation, for the purpose of asphalt milling and overlay for the not to exceed price of Two Million Two Hundred Sixty Three Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Four and 14/100 (\$2,263,464.14); and authorizing the Mayor to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Neosho.

*Bill No. 2022-46 was read in title only by Attorney Paul.*

Councilwoman Thomas made a motion to approve Bill No. 2022-46: Change Order for Blevins Asphalt Construction; Councilman Cobb seconded.

Public Works Director Siler addressed the Council stating that the purpose of this agenda item is to ask council's approval of a first amendment to the Blevins Asphalt Construction Company Overlay and Asphalt Milling project agreement. The amended agreement would add an additional tonnage to the original agreement

of 3,450 tons at the original bid price of \$72.50. This would add \$250,125 to the TIF overlay. Total overlay project will be \$2,263,464.14.

Attorney Paul stated that we are still following the purchasing policy since it is 12% of the contract price.

### **Bill No. 2022-47: MODOT Cost Share Amendment**

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City of Neosho, Missouri, to enter into a Cost Share Supplemental Agreement with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri, for the purpose of approving an amended cost share agreement related to the construction of intersection improvements at Route 86 and Hammer Road; and authorizing the Mayor to execute the same by and on behalf of the City of Neosho.

*Bill No. 2022-47 was read in title only by Attorney Paul.*

Councilman Collinsworth made a motion to approve Bill No. 2022-47: MODOT Cost Share Amendment; Councilman Davidson seconded.

City Manager Kennedy addressed the Council explaining that this agenda item is to seek the council's approval of an amendment to the MoDOT Cost Share Agreement. MoDOT initially told the City that our match would be \$863,947.00 for our cost share, once it went to their finance department it was determined that the actual amount would be \$624,697.00. This is a 50/50 cost share with MoDOT for the construction of a roundabout at Hammer Road and Highway 86.




