

Rules and Regulations

1. Park and pavilion reservations can be made between 5am-11:59pm.
2. Permit fees are non-refundable.
3. Alcohol is **NOT PERMITTED** in any of the city's parks. It is the responsibility of the permittee to ensure no alcohol is present or consumed on city property while permittee is using reserved park location.
4. Reservations must be made with the City of Neosho Parks and Recreation Department and under the supervision of the Department Director and all money shall be paid at the Neosho City Hall prior to use. Reservations may be made by phone at 451-8050, but **will not be guaranteed unless payment is made at City Hall.**
5. All permittees are responsible for cleanup of ALL trash or debris, any damages to the park while in their use, and any other cost accrued by the city due to the permittee's rental of the park (dumpster, temporary electric, portajohns, etc...) The Parks Director will inspect the park following usage of the rented park to determine if agreement has been met and if the park is in the same condition as it was prior to permittee renting it. Should physical damage be evident, the permittee will be billed accordingly and depending on the severity of damage loses future rental privileges.
6. Permittee shall not injure, mar, nor in any manner, deface said park or any equipment contained therein and shall not cause or permit any action whereby the said premises or equipment are damaged, marred, or defaced and will not make or allow to be made any alterations of any kind to said buildings or equipment contained therein and will not affix or permit to be affixed by adhesives any signs, posters, notices, or graphics of any description without the consent of City Personnel.
7. Permittee agrees that if the premises is damaged by the act, default or negligence of the permittee, patrons, guests or any person admitted to the premises by the permittee, then permittee shall pay to the City, upon demand, such sum as necessary to restore Parks Contract said premises to their original condition, excluding ordinary wear and tear expected. Refusal to pay said charges and fees by permittee can result in permanent loss of future rental and/or criminal charges being filed.
8. Permittee further agrees to abide by and conform to all rules and regulations prescribed for the management of said park by the City.
9. Permittee must provide proper supervision while the facility is in use.
10. Neosho Parks are public venues. Other civilians are permitted in different areas of the park at the time of your reservation. The area/pavilion you rent is the only location that is reserved for you and your guests during the time of rental.
11. Permittee shall not have the right to assign or sublet all or any part of the space permitted without prior consent of the City.
12. Permittee shall defend, indemnify, and hold the City harmless from and against all claims, losses, and liabilities arising out of personal injuries, including death and damage to property that may arise both out of and during activities under this agreement whether such claims are by permittee, City, or any third party.
13. Permittee shall abide by the laws of the United States, the laws of the State of Missouri, and the charter and ordinances of the City of Neosho.
14. Sidewalks, roads, or walking trails shall not be obstructed by the permittee.
